“A personal favorite in the heat of summer is the 2007 Podere Canneta di San Gimignano, from the Tuscany region of Italy (about \$25). Light and crisp with a salty-citrus finish, this Vernaccia is a knockout, especially with tilapia wrapped in prosciutto and roasted with fresh herbs. The salt and citrus bring out the clean flavors of the fish, while the mineral complexity lends itself nicely to drawing out the delicate earthiness of the herbs.”
